4. Working with your Section 5 small group, develop a one-day service learning project proposal based on one of the two following scenarios

- **Option 1:**Your group members are teaches for an online section of EAD 315 Student Leadership Training. EAD 315 is a course offered at Michigan State University for students interested in learning leadership principles, theories and techniques that meet the demands of a multicultural society. There are 25 students enrolled in the course and they live throughout the state of Michigan. They are required to complete 8 hours of service learning with a social services or non-profit organization in the following areas: education, science and the environment, or health services. Your task is to develop a one-page lesson plan to be given to your students that describes how they should identify the needs of their community and your expectations for their service learning activity. Also include a statement on how you will assist students in reflecting and making sense of their experiences.
- **Option 2**: Your group members are teachers for an online section of EAD 866 Teaching in Postsecondary Education at Michigan State University for students interested in learning effective teaching strategies. There are 25 students enrolled in the course who live throughout various states in the country. They are required to complete 8 hours of service learning with a social services agency or educational non-profit organization. The project should be related to achieving the learning objectives of the course. Your task is to develop a one-page lesson plan to be given to your students that describes how they should identify the needs of their community and your expectations for their service learning activity. Also include a statement on how you will help students reflect and make sense of their experiences.

Please post your service learning lesson plan to the discussion forum by Friday, April 10, 2009 and respond to another group's post by Monday, April 13, 2009. Your response can range from additional suggestions to asking clarifying questions and anything in between.
